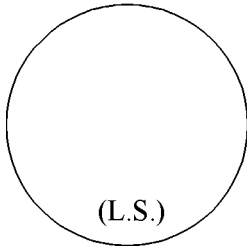

1 Name of Proclamation

This Proclamation is the *Ports Assets (Authorised Transactions) (Dissolution of Port Corporations) Proclamation 2016*.

2 Commencement

This Proclamation commences on 1 September 2016 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Dissolution of Port Kembla Port Corporation and Sydney Ports Corporation

Pursuant to clause 3 of Schedule 5 to the *Ports Assets (Authorised Transactions) Act 2012*, the following Port Corporations are dissolved:

- (a) the Port Kembla Port Corporation,
- (b) the Sydney Ports Corporation.
