The object of this Order is to update the list of employers in Schedule 1 to the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987* to include Cochrane Dam Pty Ltd. This will mean that a certain former employee of Delta Electricity whose employment is transferred to Cochrane Dam Pty Ltd following the sale by Delta Electricity of its Brown Mountain generation assets to Cochrane Dam Pty Ltd will continue to be an employee for the purposes of that Act.
