## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2007* to enable Roads and Maritime Services to issue and cancel compliance certificates in relation to heavy vehicles.

This Regulation is made under the *Road Transport Act 2013*, including sections 23 (the general statutory rule-making power) and 24 and Schedule 1.

### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Amendment (Compliance Certificates) Regulation 2016*.

### 3 Amendment of Road Transport (Vehicle Registration) Regulation 2007

#### Clause 76AA Definitions

Omit clause 76AA (2).

Insert instead:

- (2) Division 2 applies in relation to light vehicles only.  
**Note.** See Part 3.3 of the *Heavy Vehicle National Law (NSW)* with respect to the modification of heavy vehicles within the meaning of that Law.
- (3) Division 3 applies in relation to light vehicles and heavy vehicles.
