## 1 Name of Rule

This Rule is the *Legal Profession Uniform Continuing Professional Development (Barristers) Amendment (Designated Local Regulatory Authority) Rule 2016*.

## 4 Amendment of Legal Profession Uniform Continuing Professional Development (Barristers) Rules 2015

### Rule 5 Definitions

Omit “A reference in these Rules to the *designated local regulatory authority*, when used expressly or impliedly in relation to a provision of the Uniform Law, is a reference to the relevant designated local regulatory authority specified or described under jurisdictional legislation for that provision.”.

Insert instead:

*Designated local regulatory authority* means a person or body specified or described in jurisdictional legislation as the relevant designated local regulatory authority for the purposes of section 44 of the Uniform Law.
