Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Confiscation of Proceeds of Crime Regulation 2015* to update a form consequent on amendments made by the *Criminal Legislation Amendment (Organised Crime and Public Safety) Act 2016* concerning substitutable tainted property.

This Regulation is made under the *Confiscation of Proceeds of Crime Act 1989*, including sections 42B (3) and 95 (the general regulation-making power).
