Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence certain amendments made by the *Crimes (Administration of Sentences) Amendment Act 2016* to the *Crimes (Administration of Sentences) Act 1999* and the *Crimes (Administration of Sentences) Regulation 2014* in relation to the following matters:

- (a) Visiting Magistrates,
- (b) the prohibition on disclosure of information (including the penalty applying to the prohibition),
- (c) references to certain entities.
