## Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to update the list of employers in Schedule 3 to the *Superannuation Act 1916*:

- (a) to include the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation New South Wales Branch so that contributors to the State Superannuation Fund whose employment is transferred to the Australian Nursing and Midwifery Federation New South Wales Branch will continue to be contributors to that Fund for the purposes of the *Superannuation Act 1916*, and
- (b) to reflect a name change from the former New South Wales Nurses' Association (in Schedule 3 referred to as the NSW Nurses' Association) to the New South Wales Nurses and Midwives' Association that occurred on 15 August 2012.
