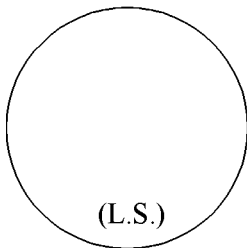

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence provisions of the *Law Enforcement Conduct Commission Act 2016* that amend the *Ombudsman Act 1974* in relation to the constitution of the Joint Committee and the power of the Joint Committee to veto proposals to appoint persons to certain roles, including the role of Chief or other Commissioner of the Law Enforcement Conduct Commission or Inspector of the Law Enforcement Conduct Commission.
