Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase the fees payable for certain applications that are made to the Secretary of the Ministry of Health in relation to the installation of warm-water systems in hospitals and the exhumation of human remains.

This Regulation is made under the *Public Health Act 2010*, including section 134 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation
