Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe various corporations as approved persons that may provide customer service functions on behalf of the Chief Executive Officer of Service NSW.

This Regulation is made under the *Service NSW (One-stop Access to Government Services) Act 2013*, including sections 12 (2) and 21 (the general regulation-making power).

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Service NSW (One-stop Access to Government Services) Act 2013

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Service NSW (One-stop Access to Government Services) Amendment (Approved Persons) Regulation 2017*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.
