Photo Card Amendment (Fees and Penalty Notice Offences) Regulation 2017

under the

Photo Card Act 2005

His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Photo Card Act 2005*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Photo Card Regulation 2014*:

- (a) to increase (from \$93 to \$94) the fee for a 10-year Photo Card if the applicant does not hold a driver licence, and
- (b) to increase (from \$52 to \$53) the fee for a 5-year Photo Card if the applicant does not hold a driver licence, and
- (c) to increase the penalties for offences dealt with by way of a penalty notice issued under the *Photo Card Act 2005*.

The increases are generally in line with movements in the Consumer Price Index.

This Regulation is made under the *Photo Card Act 2005*, including sections 5 (3), 34 and 36 (the general regulation-making power).
