Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Surveillance Devices Regulation 2014* to declare the *Crimes (Surveillance Devices) Act 2010* of the Australian Capital Territory as a corresponding law for the purposes of the definition of **corresponding law** in section 4 (1) of the *Surveillance Devices Act 2007*.

This Regulation is made under the *Surveillance Devices Act 2007*, including sections 4 (1) and 59 (the general regulation-making power).

1 Name of Regulation
