### **1 Name of Order**

This Order is the *Administrative Arrangements (Administrative Changes—Inspector of Law Enforcement Conduct Commission) Order 2017*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Order commences on 1 July 2017 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

### **3 Establishment of Office of Inspector of LECC**

The Office of the Inspector of the Law Enforcement Conduct Commission is established as a separate Public Service agency.

### **4 Transfer of certain staff from Ombudsman's Office to Office of Inspector of LECC**

The Secure Monitoring Unit in the Ombudsman's Office is transferred to the Office of the Inspector of the Law Enforcement Conduct Commission.
