Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Jury Regulation 2015* to increase (from \$242.30 to \$247.40) the daily attendance allowance that is payable to a juror (who is employed) for the juror's 11th and subsequent days of jury service.

This Regulation is made under the *Jury Act 1977*, including sections 72 (Payment for jury service) and 76 (the general regulation-making power).
