## Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence Schedule 1 to the *Transport Administration Amendment (Transport Entities) Act 2017* which makes amendments to various Acts and regulations for the following purposes:

- (a) to provide that NSW Trains and Sydney Trains are not subsidiaries of Rail Corporation New South Wales,
- (b) to establish a new corporation named Residual Transport Corporation,
- (c) to provide for the objectives, functions and management of those entities,
- (d) to make amendments that are consequential on the amendments referred to in paragraphs (a)–(c).
