## Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to approve, from 1 July 2017 until 30 June 2018, specified policies of professional indemnity insurance of Vero Insurance and Allianz Australia Limited for the purposes of clause 6 of the *Conveyancers Licensing Regulation 2015*, which requires a licensee under the *Conveyancers Licensing Act 2003*, when carrying out conveyancing work, to be insured under a policy of professional indemnity insurance approved by the Commissioner for Fair Trading.

This Order is made under clause 6 (2) (a) of the *Conveyancers Licensing Regulation 2015*.

### **1 Name of Order**

This Order is the *Conveyancers Licensing (Approved Professional Indemnity Insurance Policy) Order 2017*.

### **3 Approved policies of professional indemnity insurance**

The following policies covering the period from 1 July 2017 to 30 June 2018 are approved for the purposes of clause 6 (2) (a) of the *Conveyancers Licensing Regulation 2015*:

- (a) the master policy of professional indemnity insurance (Policy Number LPS011195725) of AAI Limited (trading as Vero Insurance) and Allianz Australia Limited,
- (b) the aggregate infill policy of professional indemnity insurance (Policy Number LPS017290468) of AAI Limited (trading as Vero Insurance).
