## Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to include a person in the non-government sector (within the meaning of the *National Disability Insurance Scheme (NSW Enabling) Act 2013*) to whom the employment of a disability services employee (within the meaning of that Act) is transferred, between 1 July 2017 and 30 June 2018, by an order of the Minister under section 14 of that Act as a class of employer in Schedule 1 to the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987*. This will ensure that employees whose employment is transferred will continue to be covered by the State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Scheme.

This Order is made under section 27 of the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987*.

### **1 Name of Order**

This Order is the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Amendment (NDIS) Order 2017*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Order is taken to have commenced on 1 July 2017 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

### **3 Amendment of State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987 No 212 Schedule 1 Employers**

Insert at the end of Part 1:

Any person in the non-government sector (within the meaning of the *National Disability Insurance Scheme (NSW Enabling) Act 2013*) to whom the employment of a disability services employee (within the meaning of that Act) is transferred, on or after 1 July 2017 and on or before 30 June 2018, by an order of the Minister under section 14 of that Act (limited to those employees whose employment is transferred by any such order)
