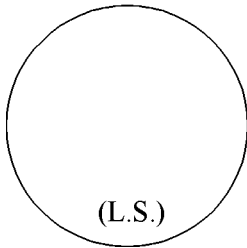
Crimes (Administration of Sentences) Amendment Act 2016 No 47

## Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence provisions of the *Crimes (Administration of Sentences) Amendment Act 2016* that transfer certain powers and associated offences relating to places of detention in Part 4A of the *Summary Offences Act 1988* to new Part 13A of the *Crimes (Administration of Sentences) Act 1999* and that make consequential amendments.
