1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Subordinate Legislation (Postponement of Repeal) Order (No 2) 2017*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Postponement of repeal of certain statutory rules

The repeal, by section 10 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*, of the following statutory rules is postponed from 1 September 2017 to 1 September 2018:

- (a) *Election Funding, Expenditure and Disclosures Regulation 2009*,
- (b) *Parliamentary Electorates and Elections Regulation 2008*.
