Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase the statutory limit on the minimum amount that may be specified by a council when levying an ordinary rate from \$506 to \$514.

This Regulation is made under the *Local Government Act 1993*, including sections 548 (3) (a) and 748 (the general regulation-making power).
