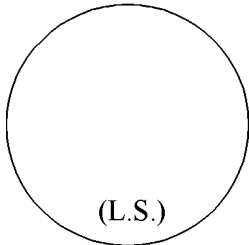

### Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence, on 1 December 2019, the remaining amendment made by the *Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Amendment (Container Deposit Scheme) Act 2016*. The amendment inserts a provision into Part 5 of the *Waste Avoidance and Resource Recovery Act 2001* that prohibits the supply of beverages in containers not bearing refund markings complying with the requirements of regulations made under that Part.
