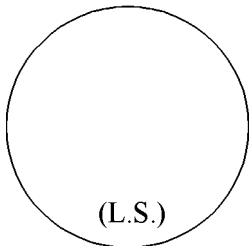

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the *Health Practitioner Regulation Amendment Act 2017* other than provisions relating to the following:

- (a) the prescription of review bodies in New South Wales for decisions made under section 127A of the Health Practitioner Regulation National Law,
- (b) the notification by a National Board of decisions to take health, conduct or performance action against registered health practitioners,
- (c) the prevention of persons using the title paramedic.
