Explanatory note

The objects of this Order are:

- (a) to notify the number that equates to the factor $\frac{B}{C}$ used in the formula for calculating the variation of the weekly payment to be paid to a worker under section 82A of the *Workers Compensation Act 1987*. That section provides that weekly payments are to be varied on 1 April and 1 October in each year, and
- (b) to notify the amount that is to apply as the minimum amount of weekly payments of compensation payable for workers with highest needs under section 38A of the *Workers Compensation Act 1987*. Section 82BA of that Act provides that the amount is to be varied on 1 April and 1 October in each year.

This Order is made under sections 82A (4) and 82BA (3) of the *Workers Compensation Act 1987*.
