## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to enable bottle shops to trade until 11 pm on any new year's eve that falls on a Sunday (including, Sunday 31 December 2017).

This Regulation is made under the *Liquor Act 2007*, including section 159 (the general regulation-making power), in particular section 159 (4).

### **1 Name of Regulation**
