# Roads Amendment (Roads Authority) Regulation 2017

under the

Roads Act 1993

His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Roads Act 1993*.

## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Roads Regulation 2008* to declare Roads and Maritime Services to be the roads authority for a certain temporary public road (to be used for residential access) off Arthur Street, Randwick, in the vicinity of the Sydney light rail project.

This Regulation is made under the *Roads Act 1993*, including sections 7 and 264 (the general regulation-making power).

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Roads Amendment (Roads Authority) Regulation 2017*.

#### **89C Roads authority for temporary public road (Sydney light rail)**

RMS is declared to be the roads authority for the temporary public road at Randwick that is Lot 5, DP 1231447.
