Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase from 6 to 8 years the total term of office that may be held by a member of a board of management for a regional sporting venues authority. Under the *Sporting Venues Authorities Act 2008*, a member of a board of management may hold office for no more than 3 years at a time.

This Regulation is made under the *Sporting Venues Authorities Act 2008*, including section 40 (the general regulation-making power) and clause 2 of Schedule 2.
