1 Name of Proclamation

This Proclamation is the *Water Management (Abolition of Anabranh Water Trust) Proclamation 2018*.

2 Commencement

This Proclamation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Abolition of Anabranh Water Trust

The Great Anabranh of the Darling River Water Trust (also known as the Anabranh Water Trust), a private water trust constituted under Part 3 of the *Water Act 1912*, is abolished.
