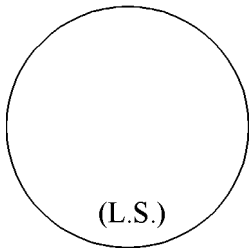

I, General The Honourable David Hurley AC DSC (Ret'd), Governor of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 (2) of the *Justice Legislation Amendment Act 2018*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint:

- (a) 16 April 2018 as the day on which Schedule 1.5 [3], [5] and [9] to that Act commence, and
- (b) 2 July 2018 as the day on which the remaining uncommenced provisions of that Act commence.

Explanatory note

The objects of this Proclamation are:

- (a) to commence on 16 April 2018 amendments to the *Criminal Procedure Act 1986* that provide that the indictable offences of recklessly dealing with proceeds of crime and perverting the course of justice may be dealt with summarily, and
- (b) to commence on 2 July 2018 the remaining uncommenced provisions of the *Justice Legislation Amendment Act 2018*.
