1 Name of Order

This Order is the *Administrative Arrangements (Administration of Acts—Amendment No 2) Order 2018*.

2 Commencement

This Order commences on 30 April 2018 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Allocation of the administration of Acts

- (1) The administration of the Acts listed in Schedule 1 are allocated to the Ministers indicated in that Schedule.
- (2) The allocations made by this Order replace any previous allocations relating to the Acts concerned that are inconsistent with the allocations made by this Order.

4 Renamed Act

The following Act subject to allocation has been renamed and its allocation is continued:

Motor Racing (Sydney and Newcastle) Act 2008 No 106 (formerly *Homebush Motor Racing (Sydney 400) Act 2008*).
