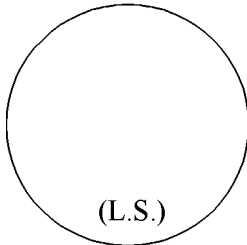
Child Protection (Working with Children) Amendment (Statutory Review)

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the *Child Protection (Working with Children) Amendment (Statutory Review) Act 2018*, except a provision of that Act that would require a person who holds or has applied for a working with children check clearance to notify the Children's Guardian of a change in the person's employer or proposed employer.
