## Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to amend Schedule 3 (Affiliated health organisations) to the *Health Services Act 1997*:

- (a) to omit Mercy Health: Albury as a recognised service under the control of Mercy Health Service Albury Limited, and
- (b) to insert Mercy Health Service Albury as a recognised service under the control of Mercy Hospitals NSW Ltd (formerly known as Mercy Care Centre, Young), and
- (c) to update the name of the organisation that controls Mercy Care Centre: Young, being Mercy Hospitals NSW Ltd (formerly known as Mercy Care Centre, Young).

This Order is made under section 62 (2) of the *Health Services Act 1997*.
