The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Surveying and Spatial Information Regulation 2017* to increase certain fees and deposits payable under the *Surveying and Spatial Information Act 2002*. The fee for an extract from the register of surveyors has not been changed.

This Regulation is made under the *Surveying and Spatial Information Act 2002*, including section 36 (the general regulation-making power).
