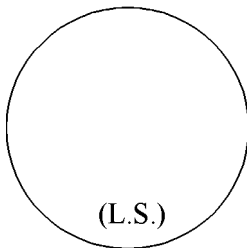
Fisheries Management Amendment Act 2015 No 59

## Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments to the *Fisheries Management Act 1994*, including amendments that:

- (a) provide that a fishing boat licence is only required for certain commercial fishing boat activities, and
- (b) remove the requirement for commercial fishing crew to be registered, and
- (c) prohibit shark finning and related practices at sea.
