Explanatory note

The object of this Rule is to increase the penalties for a driver who commits a speeding offence by exceeding a speed limit by more than 45 kilometres per hour.

This Rule is made under the *Road Transport Act 2013*, including Schedule 1 and section 23 (the general rule-making power).

1 Name of Rule

This Rule is the *Road Amendment (Penalties for Speeding Offences) Rule 2018*.

2 Commencement

This Rule commences on 1 July 2018 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.
