## Explanatory note

The object of this Order is to include Transit Systems West Services Pty Ltd in the list of employers in Schedule 3 to the *Superannuation Act 1916*. This will mean that persons:

- (a) who, immediately before 1 July 2018, were employees employed in the State Transit Authority Group of the Transport Service to work in the operation of the Region 6 Bus Services (except those employees who are Transport Service Senior Managers and Transport Service Senior Executives), and contributors to the State Superannuation Fund, and
- (b) whose employment was transferred to Transit Systems West Services Pty Ltd on that date pursuant to offers of employment made under the Transitional Agreement between the Secretary of the Department of Transport (on behalf of the State) and Transit Systems West Services Pty Ltd,

will continue to be contributors to that Fund for the purposes of the Act.

This Order is made under section 92 of the *Superannuation Act 1916*.

### **1 Name of Order**
