Criminal Legislation Amendment (Child Sexual Abuse) Act 2018 No 33

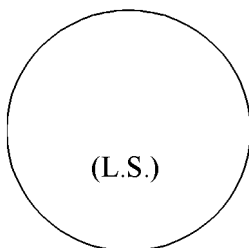
THOMAS FREDERICK BATHURST, Lieutenant-Governor

I, the Honourable Thomas Frederick Bathurst AC, Lieutenant-Governor of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Criminal Legislation Amendment (Child Sexual Abuse) Act 2018*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 31 August 2018 as the day on which the following provisions of that Act commence:

- (a) Schedule 1 [1], [54]–[59] and [62] (but only to the extent that it inserts the clause headed “Application of section 316A”),
- (b) Schedule 3 [4]–[6],
- (c) Schedule 4 [1], [6], [12] and [15],
- (d) Schedule 5.2 [5],
- (e) Schedule 5.5,
- (f) Schedule 5.12 [1].
