Parole Legislation Amendment Act 2017 No 57

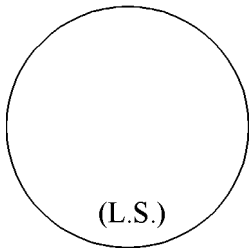

## Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments relating to the following:

- (a) statutory parole orders for adult and juvenile offenders serving sentences of 3 years or less,
- (b) revocation of parole of adult offenders and sanctions for breaches of parole by adult offenders,
- (c) parole for juvenile offenders, including determining and revoking parole, reconsideration of parole decisions and parole conditions,
- (d) parole orders by the Governor when exercising the prerogative of mercy for juvenile offenders,
- (e) other consequential changes.
