Explanatory note

Currently, certain disability services employees whose employment was transferred to a person in the non-government sector (within the meaning of the *National Disability Insurance Scheme (NSW Enabling) Act 2013*) between 1 July 2017 and 30 June 2018 can continue to be employees for the purposes of the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987*. The object of this Order is to extend the transfer period to enable other transferred employees to continue to be employees for the purposes of the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987*.

This Order is made under section 27 of the *State Authorities Non-contributory Superannuation Act 1987*.
