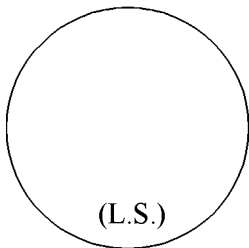
Road Transport Legislation Miscellaneous Amendments Act 2018 No 23

## Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence amendments to the *Heavy Vehicle (Adoption of National Law) Act 2013* that are consequential on changes in the Heavy Vehicle National Law. Those amendments:

- (a) omit a reference to a repealed provision in a section about the payment of the regulatory component of heavy vehicle registration charges into the National Heavy Vehicle Regulator Fund, and
- (b) omit a section about the availability of the defence of mistake of fact, which is now redundant, and
- (c) omit a reference to repealed provisions in a section about the availability of alternative orders for a person found guilty of an applicable heavy vehicle offence.
