

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence a provision that repeals Part 6A of Chapter 5A of the *Health Services Act 1997*, which relates to paramedics. Paramedics will be dealt with under the *Health Practitioner Regulation National Law (NSW)* on and from 1 December 2018.
