# Parliamentary Remuneration Amendment (Deputy Leader of the Opposition) Regulation 2018

under the

Parliamentary Remuneration Act 1989

## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to make temporary arrangements relating to the additional office holder remuneration of the Deputy Leader of the Opposition as a result of the Deputy Leader of the Opposition being a member of the Legislative Council rather than the Legislative Assembly. The temporary arrangements will apply until the day the result of the 2019 State general election is declared. The regulation also makes amendments to remove redundant provisions about temporary arrangements relating to the additional office holder remuneration of the Leader of the Opposition that applied before the 2015 State general election.

This Regulation is made under the *Parliamentary Remuneration Act 1989*, including sections 6 (4) and 21 (the general regulation-making power).

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Parliamentary Remuneration Amendment (Deputy Leader of the Opposition) Regulation 2018*.

### **2 Commencement**

This Regulation commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

**[1]      Schedule 1 Additional salaries and expense allowances**

Omit “(plus 37% until polling day for the 2015 State general election)” from the second column in Part 2.

**[2]      Schedule 1, Part 2**

Omit “(plus 12% until polling day for the 2015 State general election)” from the third column.

**[3]      Schedule 1, Part 2**

Omit “(less 37% until polling day for the 2015 State general election)” from the second column.

**[4]      Schedule 1, Part 2**

Omit “(less 12% until polling day for the 2015 State general election)” from the third column.

**[5]      Schedule 1, Part 2**

Omit the matter relating to the Deputy Leader of the Opposition in the Legislative Assembly.

Insert instead:

Deputy Leader of the Opposition in the Legislative Assembly	20% (0% until the day the result of the 2019 State general election is declared)	14% (0% until the day the result of the 2019 State general election is declared)
Deputy Leader of the Opposition, when deputy leader of a party, regardless of whether the holder of the office is a member of the Legislative Assembly or the Legislative Council	20% (0% from the day the result of the 2019 State general election is declared)	14% (0% from the day the result of the 2019 State general election is declared)
