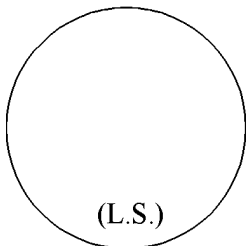

I, General The Honourable David Hurley AC DSC (Ret'd), Governor of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Road Transport Legislation Amendment (Penalties and Other Sanctions) Act 2018*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint:

- (a) 3 December 2018 as the day on which Schedule 1 [2], [10], [12]–[15] and [20] and Schedule 2.4 to that Act commence, and
- (b) 20 May 2019 as the day on which Schedule 1 [1], [3]–[9], [11] and [17]–[19], and Schedule 2.1–2.3, to that Act commence.

Explanatory note

The object of this Proclamation is to commence the amendments made by the *Road Transport Legislation Amendment (Penalties and Other Sanctions) Act 2018* on either 3 December 2018 or 20 May 2019 (except for amendments relating to requiring persons convicted of certain alcohol or other drug related driving offences to undertake education programs).
