Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to update a provision authorising the giving of a penalty notice for the offence of failing to comply with a total fire ban order under section 99 of the *Rural Fires Act 1997*. This is as a consequence of the substitution of that offence by the *Emergency Services Legislation Amendment Act 2018*.

This Regulation is made under the *Rural Fires Act 1997*, including sections 131 and 135 (the general regulation-making power).
