## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008* to increase the number of persons who can be supplied with liquid methadone or buprenorphine for the treatment of drug dependence at a retail pharmacy each day.

This Regulation is made under the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Act 1966*, including sections 24 and 45C (the general regulation-making power).

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Amendment (Supply by Pharmacists) Regulation 2018*.

### **3 Amendment of Poisons and Therapeutic Goods Regulation 2008**

**Clause 92 Supply by pharmacists of liquid methadone or buprenorphine**
