The object of this Proclamation is to commence Schedule 1 to the *Fair Trading Legislation Amendment (Consumer Guarantee Directions) Act 2018*, which inserts provisions into the *Fair Trading Act 1987* to enable the Commissioner for Fair Trading to resolve certain small consumer claims disputes by way of a direction to repair or replace, or make a refund in relation to, the consumer good concerned.
