Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to enable accused detainees to appear in first appearance bail proceedings by audio visual link during the demolition and rebuild of the Queanbeyan Police Station.

This Regulation is made under the *Evidence (Audio and Audio Visual Links) Act 1998*, including sections 5BA (2) (e) and 22 (1) (the general regulation-making power).
