Explanatory note

- (a) who, immediately before 22 October 2018, were employees of the Department of Family and Community Services and were contributors to the State Superannuation Fund, and
- (b) whose employment was transferred on 22 October 2018 pursuant to offers of employment made under a transitional agreement dated 31 October 2017 between the Secretary of the Department of Family and Community Services (on behalf of the State) and Southern Cross Community Housing Limited,

will continue to be contributors to that Fund for the purposes of the Act.
