Residential Tenancies Amendment (Review) Act 2018 No 58

- I, General The Honourable David Hurley AC DSC (Ret'd), Governor of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 2 of the *Residential Tenancies Amendment (Review) Act 2018*, do, by this my Proclamation, appoint 28 February 2019 as the day on which the following provisions commence:
- (a) Schedule 1 [1], to the extent that it inserts the definition of *domestic violence offence*,
- (b) Schedule 1 [11], [33], [37] and [38].

Explanatory note
