Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to make arrangements relating to the additional office holder remuneration of the Leader of the Opposition as a result of the interim Leader of the Opposition being a member of the Legislative Council rather than the Legislative Assembly.

This Regulation is made under the *Parliamentary Remuneration Act 1989*, including sections 6 (4) and 21 (the general regulation-making power).

Leader of the Opposition in the Legislative Assembly (when leader of a party)	57%	26%

Omit the matter relating to the Deputy Leader of the Opposition in the Legislative Assembly.

Insert instead:

Deputy Leader of the Opposition in the Legislative Assembly	20% (0% while Leader of the Opposition is a member of the Legislative Council)	14% (0% while Leader of the Opposition is a member of the Legislative Council)

Omit the matter relating to the Deputy Leader of the Opposition, when deputy leader of a party, regardless of whether the holder of the office is a member of the Legislative Assembly or the Legislative Council.
