# Liquor Amendment (Special Licence Conditions) Regulation (No 2) 2019

## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to change the list of licensed premises that are subject to the special licence conditions set out in Schedule 4 to the *Liquor Act 2007*.

This Regulation is made under the *Liquor Act 2007*, including sections 11 (1A) and 159 (the general regulation-making power).

### **1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Liquor Amendment (Special Licence Conditions) Regulation (No 2) 2019*.
